



## THIS IS A CONTRACT ENFORCEABLE IN COURT

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, UNDERSTAND THAT Hawaii law (Act 249, 1994 Hawaii Legislative Session, Effective June 29, 1994) limits the civil liability of persons sponsoring equine (horse, pony, mule, donkey, hinny) activities. I understand that there are inherent risks of injury, including death, when participating in an equine activity, which risks include, but are not limited to (1) the propensity of equine to behave in ways that may result in injury or death to persons on or around them, (2) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals, (3) hazards such as surface and sub-surface condition, (4) collisions with other equines or objects and (5) the potential negligence of another participant, such as failing to maintain control over the equine, or not acting within the participants ability. Knowing and understanding the risk of participating in an equine & livestock activity, including injury and death to my person and damage to my person, property, I expressly choose to assume these risks. Further, on behalf of my heirs, successors, representatives, and assignees. I hereby unconditionally release any and all claims and causes of action against the equine and livestock activity sponsor: Hawaii Womens' Rodeo Association and Kualoa Ranch & Activity Center. It's owners, and members, its, their, owners, shareholders, officers, directors, principals, employees, agents, representatives, and show personnel for any injury, including death and for any damage to personal property, which I may incur as a result of my participation in this activity. If the undersigned is the parent or guardian or representative of any minor participation in this activity (INCLUDING ITS, THEIR ABOVE-DESCRIBED PERSONS AND ENTITIES) FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION BROUGHT BY OR ON BEHALF OF SAID MINOR AT ANY TIME.

## RULES

- 1. BE READY TO COMPETE WHEN CALLED. 30 SECONDS FROM THE 1<sup>ST</sup> CALL TO ENTER THE ARENA.**
- 2. NO ARGUMENTS WITH THE FLAGMAN OR ARENA CREW. (ARENA DIRECTOR'S DECISION IS FINAL) NO ROUGHING THE STOCK.**
- 3. ANY DISPLAY OF UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT OR EXCESSIVE ROUGHING OF THE LIVESTOCK WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION, BY THE FLAGMAN, ARENA DIRECTOR OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS (AFTER MEETING REGARDING THE ISSUE)**
- 4. EVENT DIRECTORS WILL ACT AS THE LIASON SHOULD THERE BY ANY DISPUTES, IN NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE CONTESTANTS OR FAMILY MEMBERS TO APPROACH THE FLAGMAN OR ARENA DIRECTOR. THE CONTESTANT WILL BE IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED AND FORFEIT ENTRIES, AWARDS, AND PAYOUT.**

### STEER UNDECORATING – EVENT DIRECTOR – LISA-MARIE PADILLA

- 1. 15 SECOND TIME LIMIT – CLOSED CATCH PEN**
- 2. 10 SECOND PENALTY SHALL BE ASSESSED FOR A BROKEN BARRIER, TIME IS CALLED WHEN YOUR HAND IS ABOVE YOUR SHOULDER.**

### BREAKAWAY – EVENT DIRECTOR – MOANA TUPOU

- 1. TIME LIMIT 30 SECONDS – CLOSED CATCH PEN**
- 2. MUST USE HWRA PROVIDED RIBBON & STRING**
- 3. RIBBON AND STRING MUST BE TIED TO THE ROPE AT THE SAME PLACE, WITHIN 2 FEET FROM THE END OF THE ROPE, THE STRING MUST BE TIED TO THE SADDLE. 2 LOOPS IF YOU CARRY 2**
- 4. CATCH AS CATCH CAN, ONLY AFTER PASSING THROUGH THE HEAD OF THE STEER, ROPE MUST BE THROWN NOT PLACED**
- 5. FLAGMAN WILL CALL TIME AFTER THE STRING BREAKS.**

### DOUBLE MUGGING – EVENT DIRECTOR – KATHY RITA

- 1. 60 SECOND TIME LIMIT, NO TIME WILL BE GIVEN, IF THE CALF IS DRAGGED WITH ALL 4 LEGS OUT TO THE SIDE.**
- 2. CALF SHALL BE RELEASED FROM THE CHUTE W/A ROPE AROUND ITS NECK, THE RIDER MAY HAVE A HALF OR FULL DALLY & RIDER'S HORSE MUST BE STANDING IN THE BOX WHEN THE CALF IS RELEASED.**
- 3. PARTNER MAY NOT LEAVE THE BARREL UNTIL THE CALF PASSES THE MARKED BARREL.**
- 4. CONTESTANTS WILL RECEIVE A NO TIME FOR TOUCHING THE CALF, PIGGING STRING, OR ROPE AFTER SIGNALING FOR TIME W/OUT FLAGMAN'S CONSENT.**

### GOAT TYING – EVENT DIRECTOR – TERRY NII-APLACA

- 1. 30 SECOND TIME LIMIT**
- 2. IF THE GOAT IS DOWN, GOAT MUST BE STOOD UP AND DAYLIGHTED, ANY 3 LEGS MAY BE TIED.**
- 3. MUST REMAIN TIED FOR 6 SECONDS. CONTESTANT RECEIVES A NO TIME FOR TOUCHING THE GOAT IN ANY WAY AFTER SIGNALING FOR TIME, WITHOUT THE FLAGMAN'S CONSENT OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT.**
- 4. IF THE CONTESTANT RUNS OVER THE GOAT WHILE MOUNTED SHE WILL RECEIVE A NO TIME, IF ONLY THE HORSE RUNS OVER THE GOAT A 10 SECOND PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED.**
- 5. IF THE GOAT SHOULD BREAK AWAY BECAUSE OF THE FAULT OF THE HORSE WHILE CONTESTANT IS MOUNTED, SHE WILL RECEIVE A NO TIME.**

### TEAM ROPING – EVENT DIRECTOR – BRANDY JOSEPH

- 1. 60 SECOND TIME LIMIT – CLOSED CATCH PEN**
- 2. HEELER'S MAY TIE ON HARD & FAST.**

### 3D EVENTS – BARRELS – EVENT DIRECTOR – SANDY VAN

#### POLES – EVENT DIRECTOR – STACIE NAKASHIMA

- 1. ONLY TOP 10 FASTEST WILL RECEIVE POINTS TOWARDS THE ALL AROUND COWGIRL.**
- 2. 1<sup>ST</sup> D FASTEST TIME, 2<sup>ND</sup> D ADD 1 SECOND TO FASTEST TIME, 3<sup>RD</sup> D ADD 2 SECONDS TO FASTEST TIME .**
